

CREATE A TICK-SAFE ZONE THROUGH LANDSCAPING



1 MOW LAWN Keep your lawn mowed.

2 RAKE LEAVES Keep leaves raked and in a pile away from traffic. Leaves are where ticks lay their eggs.

3 WOOD PILE Put tick tubes on wood piles and stone walls where there are a lot of small rodents for ticks to feed on.

4 WOOD CHIPS Make a perimeter with wood chips (cedar is best or pine) or spray like bifenthrin to protect the tick-free zone. But sprays also kill our bees.

5 KEEP FERNS Leave ferns because they have a natural pesticide.
